2. GENERAL INFORMATION

- Web site of the Company www.aqua-angels.com (hereinafter the "Web site") uses cookies for its operation.

- This information about use of cookies (hereinafter the "Information") provides visitors of Web site users (hereinafter the "User" or "Users") with information about types of cookies, their settings and operation (hereinafter the "Cookies").
- From the legislative perspective (GDPR) the Cookies is a personal data that can identify User or devices that the User uses, and as such, the Web site operator is obliged to protect them and process them only in compliance with the legal conditions.
- The Company hereby fulfills its legal obligation to inform the User about the use of Cookies.

3. COOKIES

- Cookies in the http / https protocol are a small amount of data that the web server on which the website is operated sends to the browser, which is then stores it on the computer, tablet, or other device from which the User accesses the website; at each visit of the same web server, the browser then sends this data back to the web server.
- Because the http protocol is stateless, some Cookies may be necessary for the normal operation of the website.
- Other Cookies are used to improve functions and personalize content, others can monitor User preferences, can store information that is then pre-filled in forms, can allow tracking the User's movement on the Internet or websites.
- Cookies are not executable code and are not dangerous for the User's computer but may be a means of invading his privacy.

3.1. DRUHY COOKIES

- Cookies as such do not constitute executable code and are not dangerous for the User's computer but may be a means of invading his privacy.
- The visited website can store any data in the Cookies that it finds out about the User during his stay on the website, he can monitor what he is interested in, on which website he stayed longer, and he can store his way around the website.
- Cookies contain information about how long they should be kept. Some are one-time / temporary and expire when you close the browser or log out of the site, others may have a lifespan in months or years and allow the User to be recognized when visiting the website again.
- In the event of an attack on the User's computer, the attacker may obtain the User's personal data from the Cookies and may prove his identity in some cases to the web server that the User visits.

4. ZÁKONNÉ PODMÍNKY PRO POUŽITÍ COOKIES

- The Web site operator is obliged to inform in a comprehensible form about the use of cookies.
- The Web site operator is obliged to request the user's consent to the use of Cookies before they are stored on the user's computer or before the information from the Cookies is sent to the server. (See Act 468/2011 Coll. On electronic communications or Directive 2009/136 / EC of the European Parliament and of the Council). This consent can be expressed by browser settings.
- Consent is not required for Cookies, which are used only to ensure the proper functioning of the website, their optimization or are necessary for the provider to provide services that the user has explicitly requested.
- The User must be able to deactivate or reject tracking Cookies, which he can do by setting his browser. The result is less comfort when navigating the Web site.
- The User has the right to ask the data administrator (the site operator or the person who obtains the data from the cookies on the user's computer) to delete this data or to correct it if it does not correspond to the facts.

4.1. HOW TO PROHIBIT THIRD PARTY COOKIES

- The use of Cookies can be set using the user's internet browser; most browsers automatically accept cookies by default.
- Cookies can be rejected using the Internet browser or set to use only certain Cookies.
- It is also possible to set the "DO NOT TRACK" function, which sends a signal to the web server to which the user accesses that he does not wish to be tracked (sending this request alone does not ensure that he will be respected by the server); the user can create a list of third parties whose access to his computer will be blocked.
